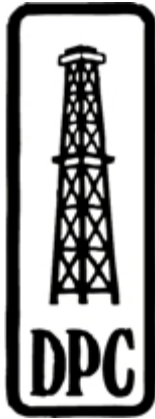

Update on Wyoming oil and gas activity, including EPA's controversial draft report on Pavillion

Dear (Contact First Name),

Thomas E. Doll is a Registered Professional Engineer in Wyoming and assumed the position of Supervisor of the Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission on May 23, 2009. He is also Wyoming's official representative to the Interstate Oil & Gas Compact Commission. Tom will provide an update on Wyoming oil and gas activity, including the EPA's recent release of a draft report on Pavillion linking hydrolic fracturing with water contamination.

BIO - After graduating from Platte Valley High School in Saratoga, WY, Tom earned his Bachelor's degree in petroleum engineering at the University of Wyoming. He began his career in the 1970's as a field engineer and worked for several oil and gas companies as a petroleum engineer, then as a drilling engineer before ascending to the level of project engineer.

Throughout his career, Tom has served on various professional boards and commissions. He served as chair of the Petroleum Association of Wyoming's Coalbed Natural Gas Committee, and served on the Wyoming Water Commission's Northeast Wyoming Basin Advisory Group and the Northeast Wyoming Sage Grouse Local Working Group. Tom has given numerous presentations on coalbed methane and has hosted numerous tours of the Powder River Basin for various county, state, federal and international agencies and regulators.
