Prior to co-founding Copper Trail, Ms. Mee focused on North Dakota Bakken non-op working interest as Vice President of Versa Energy, LLC and co-founded Cobalt Oil & Gas, LLC, an oil and gas non-operating participant in the Denver

Julesburg Basin in Colorado currently managing a portfolio of \$45mm in assets.

In the midstream business development space, Ms. Mee participated in greenfield project development, system acquisitions, divestitures and crude oil marketing initially as a business development representative for Momentum Energy Group, LLC, a Yorktown Energy Partners, Bank of America and Lehman Brothers backed midstream startup. While at Momentum Ms. Mee's role was centered on system growth of the Collbran Valley Gas Gathering System as well as the acquisition of Kinder Morgan's Powder River gathering system. Upon the sale of Momentum Energy Group to DCP Midstream in 2007, Ms. Mee served as Corporate Secretary and Business Development Manager at Arista Midstream Services, LLC, where she focused on the Paradox Basin gathering system and processing plant project until asset divestiture in 2009 later acquiring the remaining Arista Midstream crude oil marketing business from her partners in 2011. Ms. Mee was a founding member, Business Development Manager and Corporate Secretary for Meritage Midstream Services, LLC, an EnCap Flatrock Midstream and Tudor Pickering & Holt backed midstream company where she supported the successful build-out and sale of assets in the Eagleford Basin in 2012. Following Meritage Midstream's divestiture, Ms. Mee continued to own and operate Arista Midstream's crude oil marketing business as well as investing directly in working interests and minerals with the support of institutional and family office investors for the past five years. She has been managing a portfolio of \$45mm in assets, with interests in over 500 wells, for the past four years.

Ms. Mee sits on the Denver Petroleum Club Board of Directors and is a member of the Rocky Mountain Chapter of the Gas Processors Association. Ms. Mee graduated from the University of New Mexico with a BA, emphasis on Business.
